Fares: Payable on boarding. Bus Passes are available for purchase in Transit office.

DAILY DEMAND RIDE: \$0.50 (within city limits)

"RIDE TO WORK": \$3.00 per day

*IN-COUNTY RIDE: \$2.00

*MULTIPLE COUNTY RIDE: \$7.00 per county

*Requires 72 hour notice.

Personal care attendants ride free.

Children 12 yrs & under ride free w/ paying adult. Infant seat/Booster seats are not provided. Must be at least 16 yrs old to ride alone.

*All rides are based on availability, and to better serve you, please call early.

"RIDE TO WORK" ROUTES
