

MUSCOGEE (CREEK) NATION CORONAVIRUS CITIZEN INCOME SUPPORT PROGRAM

§1-101. Eligibility

Muscogee (Creek) Nation (“MCN”) enrolled Citizens 18 years or older shall be eligible to apply for the Coronavirus Income Support Program if the citizen:

- has experienced a job loss or a reduction in income due to the Coronavirus Pandemic; or
- receives their primary monthly income under the Social Security Act; or
- receives Veterans Administration disability; and
- has not received an award for the same citizen through the MCN Coronavirus Hardship Program.

§1-102. Policy

It shall be the policy of MCN to provide one time income relief to eligible MCN Citizens consistent with Section 101 and Title V of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”), the Coronavirus Relief Fund.

§1-103. Procedures

Procedures to apply for financial relief shall be as follows:

- A. Applicant must complete an application for assistance with the MCN Social Services Office.
- B. Applicant must submit:
 - i. verification of MCN citizenship; and
 - ii. loss or reduction of income; or
 - iii. award from the Social Security or Veterans Administration.
- C. The Social Services Office shall review the Applicant materials for eligibility and adherence to MCN law and this policy.
- D. The Social Services Office shall initiate payment consistent with this policy.
- E. The Finance Department will issue a one thousand five hundred and/no dollars (\$1,500.00) payment to approved Applicants.

§1-104. Administration of Program

The Social Services Office shall be authorized to administer the Program.
